1 The Board shall be responsible for specifying its requirements and expectations of the superintendent  
2 and then holding the superintendent accountable by evaluating how well those requirements and  
3 expectations have been met. In turn, the superintendent shall be responsible for specifying  
4 requirements and expectations for all administrators who report to him/her and then holding each  
5 accountable by evaluating how well requirements and expectations have been met.

6 The legislation of policies is the most important function of a school board, and the execution of the  
7 policies is the function of the Superintendent. The Board delegates its administrative powers to the  
8 Superintendent to manage the schools within established policies.

9 The Board pursuant to the law will authorize all expenditures through the budget process, grant tenure  
10 to licensed educators upon the Superintendents' recommendation, sustain or over rule the dismissal of  
11 tenured teachers upon the proof presented, approve the annual budget, and determine policies, but will  
12 perform these functions after considering recommendations by the Superintendent. The decision of the  
13 Board concerning these matters shall regulate the actions of the Superintendent and staff.
