1 All visitors shall report to the school office when entering the school. Authorization to visit elsewhere in the

2 building or on the school campus will be determined by the principal or his designee. All persons, other than

3 enrolled students and employees of the school system, shall obtain and prominently display a visitor's pass

4 issued by the principal.

5 In order to maintain the conditions and atmosphere suitable for learning, no other person shall enter onto the

6 grounds or into the school buildings during the hours of student instruction except students assigned to that

7 school, the staff of the school, parents of students, approved school volunteers, and other persons with lawful

8 and valid business on the school premises. Visitor access shall be limited to monitored entrances during school

9 hours.

10 The principal or his designee has the authority to exclude from the school premises any persons disrupting the

educational programs in the classroom or in the school, disturbing the teachers or students on the premises, or on

12 the premises for the purpose of committing an illegal act.

13 Sales representatives are not permitted to call, collectively or individually, on the staff members of a school

14 without authorization from the school's administration or the Superintendent of Schools. Principals shall

15 determine times when it is convenient and appropriate to contact staff members. Furthermore, principals may

16 refuse to admit sales representatives to school premises. Staff members shall not discuss personal business with

17 sales representatives during school hours.
