- 1 The Board shall develop comprehensive, long-range plans based on the following:
- 2 1. Developing and implementing a written five-year plan to include a mission statement, goals,  
3 objectives, strategies, and address the State Board of Education Master Plan and such plan shall  
4 be updated every two years;<sup>1</sup>
- 5 2. Establishing annual program improvement objectives, including major activities, expected  
6 outcomes, time-lines, responsible persons and required resources; and
- 7 3. Basing major budget decisions on long-range plans.
- 8 Each principal of each school shall work with the superintendent to develop and implement a school  
9 improvement plan. The plan shall be updated every two years and include areas such as curriculum,  
10 instruction, professional development, and community partnerships, and address the long-range strategic  
11 plan of the school system.<sup>1</sup>
- 12 The Board may plan a retreat when appropriate with the superintendent and appropriate staff. The  
13 purpose of the retreat shall be to review progress on the implementation of priorities, initiatives, and  
14 long-range plans; to determine which goals have been achieved and whether any new efforts are needed;  
15 and to review major issues that may affect the school system in the future.
- 16 The superintendent shall develop necessary procedures, forms or other measures to implement the  
17 goals of this policy.
