1 The Board shall establish school attendance areas and periodically review boundary adjustments. The
2 director of schools shall enforce these areas as established by the Board.

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4 The primary considerations governing the establishment of a school attendance area are:

- 5 1. The educational opportunity afforded students;
- 6 2. The capacity of each school; and
- 7 3. The geographic location of each school in relationship to the surrounding student population.

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10 Students who use the school bus service must attend the school in the zone in which they reside. Students
11 who use transportation other than the school bus service shall be permitted to attend any school which
12 is appropriate for their level.

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14 Following the first full week of school, principals will allow transfer of students from one school to another
15 only when the parent/guardian has moved his/her residence to that school's attendance area. Exceptions
16 to this policy must be approved by the director of schools or his/her designee.

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18 Parents who are dissatisfied with the assignment of their children may, within ten (10) days after the
19 assignment, make application to the Board for a hearing requesting a transfer to another school.¹
