1 *General*

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3 The Board shall practice sound fiscal management procedures which guarantee maximum use of all
4 resources provided. The Board assumes responsibility, within its financial capabilities, for providing at
5 public expense all items of equipment, supplies and services that may be required in the interest of
6 education in the schools under its jurisdiction.¹

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8 In fiscal management, the Board seeks to achieve the following goals:

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- 10 1. To engage in advance planning, with broad-based staff and community involvement;
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 - 12 2. To establish levels of funding which will provide quality education for the system's students;
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 - 14 3. To use the available techniques for budget development and management;
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 - 16 4. To provide timely and appropriate information to all staff with fiscal management responsibilities;
 - 17 and
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 - 19 5. To establish efficient procedures for accounting, reporting, purchasing and delivery, payroll,
 - 20 payment of vendors and contractors, and all other areas of fiscal management.
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 - 22 6. To establish and maintain a compensation system that will:
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 - 24 a. attract, retain and reward qualified personnel at all levels of responsibility;
 - 25 b. reflect the difficulty and responsibility of jobs;
 - 26 c. be externally competitive, internally consistent and fair; and
 - 27 d. motivate employees to work toward achievement of the system's goals.
