## 1 *General*

2  
3 All school system budgets are the operational plans stated in financial terms which describe the programs  
4 to be conducted during the fiscal year beginning July 1 ending June 30 the following year.

### 7 8 **PREPARATION PROCEDURES**

9  
10 Budget planning shall include an analysis of previous staffing, curriculum and facilities, and projections  
11 requiring additional staffing, curriculum modifications, and additional facilities.

12  
13 The budget proposal should be balanced, consistent with board policy and contract conditions, to include  
14 provisions for:

- 15 • Programs to meet the needs of the entire student body
- 16 • Staffing arrangements adequate for proposed programs
- 17 • Maintenance of the district's equipment and facilities
- 18 • Efficiency and economy <sup>1</sup>

19  
20 Budget preparation shall be the responsibility of the director of schools. The director of schools will  
21 establish procedures for the involvement of staff, including requests from department heads and princi-  
22 pals, all of whom shall seek advice and suggestions from other staff and faculty members.

23  
24 The director of schools and the chairman of the board shall develop a budget preparation calendar no  
25 later than March 1 of the current school year.<sup>4</sup> The calendar shall be used as a guide for coordinating  
26 the budgetary activities of individuals and groups, collecting budget data, reviewing budget problems,  
27 and making budget decisions.

### 28 29 **HEARING AND REVIEWS**

30  
31 The proposed budget will be available for inspection by various interested citizens or groups in the of-  
32 fice of the director of schools.

### 33 34 **FINAL ADOPTION PROCEDURE**

35  
36 The board shall submit a proposed budget in accordance with the budget timeline established by the  
37 board and county commission.<sup>2</sup> If a budget timeline is not agreed upon, the board shall submit a pro-  
38 posed budget to the County Commission no later than May 1st.<sup>2</sup> If the proposed budget is rejected, the  
39 board shall submit a revised budget proposal within ten (10) business days after receiving notice of the  
40 rejection.<sup>5</sup>

41  
42 Within ten (10) days of adoption of the final budget, the director of schools shall file a copy with the  
43 Commissioner of Education.<sup>3</sup>
