General

When equipment, books, materials, and other personal property no longer have an intended use by the system or are no longer capable of being used because of condition, the Board shall declare them surplus property and authorize their disposal.¹

A committee shall be established to oversee the sale of surplus property of the Board of Education. Committee members will be appointed by the director of schools. When surplus property becomes available this committee will meet and decide the proper procedure for the disposal of such.

Technology Equipment

The Board declares technology personal property that has been determined by the technology coordinator, in consultation with the director of schools, to no longer have an intended use by the system and/or is no longer capable of being used because of condition, as being surplus and such personal property may be disposed without further Board approval. When such property is considered surplus, a report of items disposed shall be included on the next Board agenda under the consent agenda.
