Sensitive minor equipment is defined as "items purchased with a cost between \$100 and \$5,000.00." It includes items such as computers, external computer peripherals, etc., as determined by the State Personal Property Section.

Purchasing - The Hardin County School System will budget sufficient funds for planned purchases of any items to be considered to be equipment by the approved definitions. The Hardin County School System will maintain all supporting documentation: Inventory records, purchase orders, receipts, and vendor contracts.¹

Equipment Inventory (EDGAR Section 80.32) - The Hardin County School System will maintain an inventory of equipment purchased with local, state, and federal funds until disposition takes place.

The property/inventory records must include the following information:

- Description of property
- A serial number
- Other identification numbers, if needed
- The source of the property
- Who holds title
- The acquisition date
- Cost of the property
- Percentage of Federal participation in the cost of the property
- The location, use, and condition of the property
- Any ultimate disposition data including date of disposal and the sale price of the property
