Rescinds:

1 The Board recognizes that certain employees may need to use their private vehicles for school purposes. With the use of private vehicles, the following policy shall be observed: 2

**Private Vehicles** 

- To use a private vehicle for school purposes, the employee must have the written permission of the 3 1. superintendent/designee and proof of vehicle liability insurance coverage in a sufficient amount, as 4 5 determined by the superintendent.
- 2. The school system shall assume no responsibility for liability in case of accident, unless the 6 employee has the proper authorization described above. 7
- 8 3. The Board specifically forbids any employee to transport students for school purposes without 9 prior authorization by the superintendent or his/her designee.
- 4. Privately-owned school buses and drivers of such shall meet all requirements of state law and state 10 Board Rules, Regulations, and Minimum Standards.<sup>2</sup> 11
- 5. No student shall be sent on personal errands in a vehicle owned by the student, an employee, or the 12 system. Students may only be sent on school-related errands with written parental permission and 13 proof of student insurance. 14
- 15 6. No employee may ask for or give permission to students to transport other students to and from any school or school-related activity without written parental permission and proof of student 16 17 insurance.
- 18 The Board recognizes that volunteer parent drivers are often needed to use their private vehicles for
- school purposes. The volunteer parent drivers who use a private vehicle must provide proof of vehicle 19
- liability insurance coverage in the form of an insurance certificate in a sufficient amount, as 20
- determined by the superintendent.<sup>1</sup> 21
