The Board recognizes that certain employees may need to use their private vehicles for school purposes.
 With the use of private vehicles, the following policy shall be observed:

- To use a private vehicle for school purposes, the employee must have the written permission of the
   director of schools/ designee and proof of vehicle liability insurance coverage in a sufficient amount,
   as determined by the director of schools.
- 6 2. The school system shall assume no responsibility for liability in case of accident, unless the employee
  7 has the proper authorization described above.
- The Board specifically forbids any employee to transport students for school purposes without prior
   authorization by the director of schools or his/her designee.
- Privately-owned school buses and drivers of such shall meet all requirements of state law and state
   Board Rules, Regulations, and Minimum Standards.<sup>2</sup>
- 5. No student shall be sent on errands, personal or school-related, in a vehicle owned by the student, anemployee, or the school system.
- Ko employee may ask for or give permission to students to transport other students to and from any school or school-related activity without written parental permission and proof of student insurance.
- 16 The Board recognizes that volunteer parent drivers are often needed to use their private vehicles for 17 school purposes. The volunteer parent drivers who use a private vehicle must provide proof of vehicle
- 18 liability insurance coverage in the form of an insurance certificate in a sufficient amount, as
- 19 determined by the director of schools.<sup>1</sup>
