1 In keeping with the State Board of Education's endorsement of the Early Admission Program,¹ local
2 boards of education may adopt policies providing for college level courses to be conducted during the
3 school day on the high school campus. Such courses may be taught by licensed teachers or bona fide
4 college instructors approved by the local school system and the post secondary institution. These courses
5 are to be considered a part of the school program, with content and instruction subject to the supervision
6 of the principal of the school and the local Board of Education. Dual credit (high school and college)
7 may be offered under this option.

9 To be considered for this program, the student shall:

- 10 1. Earn a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 based on a 4.0 scale;
- 11 2. Earn an ACT composite of at least 20;
- 12 3. The student must be in good standing; and
- 13 4. The student must have the approval of the high school principal.
