- The following guidelines shall be followed in administering school-sponsored extracurricular
 activities:
- The Board shall initially approve each extracurricular activity to ensure proper support and supervision.
- 5 2. The principal, after obtaining the recommendation of the faculty and the director of schools,
 6 shall determine which clubs and organizations will be permitted.
- 7 3. Each student activity must be under the guidance and direction of a certified staff member.
- 8 4. All extracurricular activities and clubs must have the approval of the principal.
- 9 5. Student activities occurring before or after regularly scheduled school hours must be under the supervision of the principal or his/her designee.
- 11 6. Secret organizations shall not be operated in any school.
- A student shall not be required to attend an extracurricular activity that is scheduled at a time
 which conflicts with his/her religious practices.
- School-sponsored student activities during vacation periods shall be restricted to regularly
 scheduled athletic programs and major events which cannot be scheduled otherwise.
- Student groups shall not participate in state or national activities which are not listed as
 approved activities by a regional accrediting association or the state and national principals'
 associations without the approval of the Director of Schools.
- 10. A student on out-of-school suspension shall not be permitted to participate in extracurricular
 activities.
- 11. Activities which restrict participation because of race, color, religion, sex, disabilities, or
 national origin are strictly forbidden.¹
- 12. Activities sponsored by outside groups or agents will be approved only if they are co-sponsored
 by the school.
