1 All classrooms and learning centers shall be equipped with the instructional materials needed to
2 provide quality learning experiences for students.

3 The Board seeks to provide a wide range of instructional materials that cover all levels of difficulty,
4 generate critical thinking, and support the educational programs. The director of schools shall develop
5 procedures to review and reconsider instructional materials that are allegedly inappropriate.

6 A list of instructional materials shall be revised annually by the principal under the direction of the
7 director of schools.

8 The director of schools shall develop procedures for the inspection of materials and distribute these
9 procedures to each principal.¹ Upon request, parents/guardians shall have the ability to inspect the
10 following items: instructional materials; teaching materials; teaching aids; handouts; and tests that are
11 developed by and graded by their child's teacher.
