1 Students must be enrolled full time at the home base school to be eligible for ranking among the top  
2 high school seniors.

3  
4 All grades earned in grades 9, 10, 11, and through the third grading period of grade 12 will be counted  
5 toward the grade point average and class ranking with the following exceptions: Grades shall be awarded  
6 but not included in GPA or class ranking for Band, Chorus, Community Service, Co-op, Physical Educa-  
7 tion, Plume, and Newspaper. (Band and/or Chorus grades, when used to meet the Fine Arts credit for  
8 graduation, will be counted toward GPA and class ranking.)

9  
10 Honor roll students will be determined by standards approved by the Board. Students who meet these  
11 standards, and who do not request otherwise, will have their names submitted to the principal for release  
12 to the news media.

13  
14 Each school department or club which presents honors or awards or conducts contests will file with the  
15 principal the name of the honor, award or contest; the basis for selection of the award and honor; the  
16 method of participation; and the reason for the contest.

17  
18 To become valedictorian or salutatorian, a student must be enrolled in the high school at least four (4)  
19 of the seven (7) semesters preceding the final semester. The final nine-week grading period will not be  
20 used in determining class standing.

21  
22 Students must complete the requirements for the Distinguished Scholar Diploma in order to be considered  
23 for Valedictorian, Salutatorian, Historian, Top Ten Percent and Class Rank.
