1 Students must be enrolled full time at the home base school to be eligible for ranking among the top
2 high school seniors.

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4 All grades earned in grades 9, 10, 11 and the first semester of grade 12 will be counted toward the
5 grade point average and the rank in class.

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7 Honor roll students will be those with a 93 or above average and complete the following courses. Stu-
8 dents who meet these standards, and who do not request otherwise, will have their names submitted to
9 the principal for release to the news media.

10 COURSES

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12 **English** - 4 years- Honors English

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14 **Math**- Algebra I, Algebra II, geometry plus an upper level math course

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16 **Science**- Lower level science course, biology, chemistry plus an upper level science course

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18 **Other courses** of their choosing to complete the graduation requirements.

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20 **Transfer Students** must be in attendance for a minimum of two years before being
21 considered for the valedictorian or salutatorian award and meet all requirements.

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24 Each school department or club which presents honors or awards or conducts contests will file with the
25 principal the name of the honor, award or contest; the basis for selection of the award and honor; the
26 method of participation; and the reason for the contest.

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28 The valedictorian or salutatorian, shall be the honor students with the highest and second highest
29 GPA.

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
