1 If the Board determines that it is in the best interest of the school district, application may be made to the  
2 commissioner of education for a waiver of any state board rule or regulation that inhibits or hinders the  
3 Board's ability to implement programs designed to improve student achievement.<sup>1</sup> However, the Board  
4 will not seek a waiver from those rules and regulations which by statute the Commissioner of Education  
5 is prohibiting from granting.

7 Further, the Board may request from the Commissioner of Education a waiver of state law, rule or regula-  
8 tion from maximum class sizes in the event a natural disaster has caused displaced students to become  
9 enrolled in the school district.<sup>2</sup>
