1 Annually, the director of schools shall be responsible for conducting a needs assessment to determine the  
2 focus of extended contract activities. The needs assessment shall be conducted by an extended contract  
3 committee, which shall advise on or certify to the need for specific programs served through extended  
4 contracts. The committees shall consist of teachers and administrators, Career Level III and II teachers  
5 where possible, as determined by the Board.<sup>1</sup>

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7 Extended contract opportunities shall be available to all educators, provided Career Level III and II  
8 educators are given priority of opportunity.<sup>1</sup>

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10 The director of schools shall be responsible for devising a plan for Board approval consistent with the  
11 needs assessment. The plan shall include as a minimum:

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- 13 1. A description of each program and a discussion of the benefits of the program as required by state  
14 law;<sup>1</sup>
- 15 2. Time frames within which the program(s) will be operated;<sup>1</sup>
- 16 3. The number of students who will benefit from the program;
- 17 4. A list of additional duties which may be assigned to Career Level educators at each Career Level'
- 18 5. The number and special qualifications of employees desired for each program; and
- 19 6. Local costs to be involved in the program.
