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1 The intent of this policy is to allow employees the opportunity to attend funeral services of an immediate 2 family member. Each employee shall be entitled to take three (3) days of bereavement leave for the death 3 of a member of his/her immediate family. Immediate family shall be defined as parent, spouse, child, 4 sibling, grandparents, grandchildren, stepparents, mother-in-law, father-in-law, daughter-in-law, son-in-5 law, brother-in-law, sister-in-law, or stepchildren. Said leave shall not be deducted from employee's 6 accumulated sick leave or personal leave. Bereavement days must be taken consecutively unless 7 approved by the director of schools. No employee is entitled to take more than six (6) days in any given 8 school year. 9
