1 In keeping with the educational purpose of MCS schools, all personnel are expected to dress and groom
2 themselves with a sense of professionalism. Each employee is expected to keep his or her person and
3 clothing clean and neat. It is expected that each employee, while exercising his or her right to dress in
4 an individual way, will also show through his or her appearance a high degree of respect for the standards
5 of decency, cleanliness, and style generally accepted by the school and community. The following will
6 apply to employee dress when students are present.

8 ***Appropriate/Acceptable Attire:***

- 10 - Dress and casual shirts
 - 11 - Dress and casual slacks
 - 12 - Jeans
 - 13 - Dress and casual shoes
 - 14 - Ties
 - 15 - Dresses, jumpers, dress shorts and skirts (must be knee length or longer)
 - 16 - Leggings with appropriate knee length top/dress
 - 17 - School logo shirts

19 ***Inappropriate/Unacceptable Attire:***

- 21 - Shirts, blouses, or tops that are strapless or have spaghetti straps
 - 22 - Shirts, blouses, or tops that are not long enough to be tucked in
 - 23 - Tight, sheer, exposing, low-cut, or revealing articles of clothing
 - 24 - Leggings worn as pants
 - 25 - Exercise/yoga attire
 - 26 - T-shirts
 - 27 - Any article of clothing which is baggy, saggy, holey, frayed, or bleached out
 - 28 - Visible piercings, other than ears

30 ***Exceptions:***

- 31
- 32 - Casual jeans are permitted for Technology Department employees, CTE/Occupational teachers,
33 bus drivers, custodians, and maintenance staff.
 - 34 - Knee length shorts may be worn by bus drivers.
 - 35 - Physical education teachers may dress appropriately for the day's planned activities.
 - 36 - Attire for special activities (ex: field trips, field day) is allowed per principal approval.
