- 5 3. Develop improvements in the administrative leadership of the school system.
- 6 The Board will develop, with the director, a set of performance objectives based on the needs of the system.
- The performance of the director will be reviewed in accordance with these specified goals. The performance 7
- objectives will be memorialized in an evaluation plan that includes, at a minimum, sections regarding job 8
- performance, student achievement, relationships with staff and personnel, relationships with board members, 9

- At a time agreed to by the Board and the director, the Board will meet as a body to evaluate the director's 11 12 performance.
- 13 The following guidelines will be used in the evaluation process:
- 14 1. The director will know the standards upon which they will be evaluated and will be involved in the development of those standards. 15
 - 2. A part of the evaluation may be a composite of the evaluation by individual board members, but the Board, as a whole, will meet with the director to discuss the composite evaluation.
- 18 3. The evaluation shall include a discussion of strengths as well as weaknesses.
- 19 4. Both the Board and director will prepare for the evaluation; the director will conduct a self- evaluation and board members will document the evidence used in rating the director's performance. 20
- 5. All documentation will be supported by objective evidence. 21
