1 Students residing outside the boundaries of the McNairy County School System may attend schools
2 within the school system under the following conditions:

- 4 1. They must be approved by the director of schools.¹
- 5
- 6 2. They must pay a tuition fee established annually by the Board. Annual tuition may not exceed
7 per student, per annum, an amount equal to the amount of funds actually used for school purposes
8 by the school system per student during the preceding school year minus any funds received from
9 the state or from the student's resident system. Tuition for out-of-state non-resident students shall
10 be charged at the same rate as the average cost per student in the system attended.²

- 12 3. Non-resident students must make application at least two weeks prior to the first day of school.
- 13
- 14 4. Requests from students from adjoining states to attend school shall be considered on a case-by-
15 case basis.³
- 16
- 17 5. Students who become residents of the school system will be refunded any unused portion of the
18 tuition on a pro-rata basis.
- 19
- 20 6. When payment is not made on all or any part of the required tuition for a previous year, the
21 student(s) shall be excluded from future attendance until all prior and current tuition is paid.
- 22
- 23 7. If a parent of a student teaches outside the school system of the parent's residency, the student
24 may attend such school system if the appropriate tuition requirements are met, provided that there
25 is available room and teaching capacity and other determinations made by the Board according
26 to applicable law.⁴

- 28 8. Children of nonresident (out-of-state) teachers of the McNairy County School District may attend
29 a school in the McNairy County School System without tuition charge.
- 30
- 31 9. Parents that give inaccurate information on their child's registration form will subject the child
32 to being removed from the school roster.
- 33
- 34 10. Students should have satisfactory attendance, conduct, and academic achievement at their previ-
35 ous school in order to transfer to a McNairy County school.
- 36
- 37 11. This policy will be implemented beginning with the 2001-2002 school year. Non-resident stu-
38 dents who are currently enrolled in the McNairy County School System will be exempted from
39 this policy.
