1 **TO SCHOOLS**

2
3 Students in grades K-5 are expected to attend the school to which they are assigned by virtue of their
4 residence. Students will enroll in the school of appropriate grade¹ as designated by school zones based
5 upon the student's primary residence and will be provided transportation, if the distance is one and one-
6 fourth (1 1/4) miles or more.

7
8 All students grades K-5 are eligible to apply for acceptance to magnet school. If student meets all en-
9 rollment criteria and is accepted, transportation shall be provided.

10
11 Parents of students in grades 6-12 may elect to enroll their children in any school in the school system
12 provided the parent provides transportation to and from that respective school and provided that such
13 choice does not cause overcrowding in the chosen school.

14
15 The Bedford County Board of Education will not issue waivers of student assignment.

17 **TO CLASSES**

18
19 The principal shall be responsible for assigning all students to classes.

20
21 Students who enter the system from another school system are to be placed by the principal in the grade
22 and/or level as indicated by records from the former school. If the student's placement is inappropriate
23 in the grade or level assigned, he/she may be reassigned by the principal to another grade level. Parents
24 shall be kept advised.
