1 **TO SCHOOLS**

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3 Students, including those in kindergarten, are expected to attend the school to which they are assigned
4 by virtue of their residence.¹

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6 Parents who are dissatisfied with the assignment of their children may, within ten (10) days after the
7 assignment, make application to the Board for a hearing requesting a transfer to another school.²

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9 **TO CLASSES**

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11 The principal shall be responsible for assigning all students to classes.

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13 Students who enter the system from another school system are to be placed by the principal in the grade
14 and/or level as indicated by records from the former school. If the student's placement is inappropriate
15 in the grade or level assigned, he/she may be reassigned by the principal to another grade level. Parents
16 shall be kept advised.

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18 The principal will separate an alleged victim of child sexual abuse, from an alleged perpetrator. If avail-
19 able and appropriate, a child shall be reassigned if a request is made by the child's parent or custodian and
20 the perpetrator has been: (1) substantiated by the department of children's services; (2) adjudicated by a
21 juvenile court to have committed the child sexual abuse; or (3) criminally charged.³
