1 Transfer students will meet the same enrollment requirements as new students.

2
3 Up to two (2) weeks prior to the beginning of the school year, a student may choose to attend a school
4 within the system other than the one to which he is zoned.** However, the student must provide his
5 own transportation to and from the school.

6
7 After a student has enrolled in one (1) school within the system, he will not be permitted to transfer
8 to another unless there is a change in residence of the student's parents or guardian outside the area in
9 which the student enrolled. Any exception to this policy must be brought before the director of schools
10 for evaluation and decision.

11
12 Principals shall allow credit for work transferred from other schools only when substantiated by official
13 transcripts or successful completion of comprehensive written examinations approved, administered and
14 graded by the principal or his designated representative.¹

15
16 Students transferring into the school system from other districts must have the approval of both the
17 sending and receiving school systems. It is preferred such transfers occur at the beginning of a grading
18 period and/or semester.

20 Priority Order: In-zone students; full-time ECS employees (tuition waiver students); full-time employee
21 out-of-zone students; returning out-of-zone students; siblings of returning out-of-zone students; new out-
22 of-zone students; returning tuition students; siblings of returning tuition students; new tuition students.
