- 1 Transfer students will meet the same enrollment requirements as new students.
- 2
- 3 Up to two (2) weeks prior to the beginning of the school year, a student may choose to attend a school
- 4 within the system other than the one to which he/she is zoned.\*\* However, the student must provide his/
- 5 her own transportation to and from the school.
- 6
- 7 After a student has enrolled in one (1) school within the system, he/she will not be permitted to transfer
- 8 to another unless there is a change in residence of the student's parents or guardian outside the area in
- 9 which the student enrolled. Any exception to this policy must be brought before the superintendent for
- 10 evaluation and decision.
- 11
- 12 Students whose families transfer their residence to another school area after the first month of school may
- 13 complete the school year at their former school. Students who present evidence that they will move during
- 14 the school year and who desire to enroll in a new school in the new area may do so with prior written
- 15 request for a change of school area. The superintendent may grant other exceptions to this policy for good
- 16 and sufficient reasons.

- 18 Principals shall allow credit for work transferred from other schools only when substantiated by official
- 19 transcripts or successful completion of comprehensive written examinations approved, administered and
- 20 graded by the principal or his/her designated representative.<sup>1</sup>
