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2 The director of schools shall be responsible for the overall implementation and supervision of the
3 Board's Code of Behavior and Discipline and shall ensure that students at all schools are subject to a
4 uniform and fair application of the Code.

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6 The principal of each school shall be responsible for implementation and administration in his/her school
7 and shall apply the Code uniformly and fairly to each student at the school without partiality and
8 discrimination.

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10 The Board delegates to the director of schools the responsibility of developing more specific codes of
11 behavior and discipline which are appropriate for each level of school, namely, elementary, middle,
12 junior high and senior high. The development of each code shall involve principals and faculty members
13 of each level of school and shall be consistent with the content of the Board's Code.

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15 The Code shall be posted on the school system's web-site, readily accessible to all students, parents,
16 and employees; school counselors are encouraged to utilize the Code for discussion with students and
17 parents. The code shall be referenced in all school handbooks. A printed copy of the Code may be
18 obtained upon request at each school.¹
