1 Students shall dress and groom in a clean, neat and modest manner so as not to distract or interfere with
2 the operation of the school.

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4 More specific guidelines appropriate for each level of school (elementary, middle, junior high and senior
5 high) may be developed. ¹ Principals, faculty members and students shall be involved in the development
6 of each appropriate set of guidelines.

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8 When a student is attired in a manner which is likely to cause disruption or interference with the opera-
9 tion of the school, the principal shall take appropriate action, which may include suspension.

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11 **STUDENTS K-3**

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13 Shorts of appropriate length are allowed. The mid-thigh rule does not apply.

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15 **STUDENTS 4-12**

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17 1. Any attire (shorts, skirts, skorts) are to be worn at mid-thigh. Each shall be hemmed.
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19 2. Pants and shorts must be worn at the waistline.
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21 3. Top/shirts should fall below the waist.
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23 4. T-shirts shall not have written slogans/messages which contain: Advertisement of drugs or alcohol
24 or contain vulgar or sexually explicit messages (direct or implied).
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26 5. T-shirts shall not contain any messages, slogans, or symbols that promote racial discord.
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28 6. Jewelry - All facial jewelry shall be limited to the ear.
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30 7. No tank tops.
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32 8. No full length coats.
