- Students shall not possess personal communication devices, such as pagers and cellular phones, while 1
- on school property or while attending a school-sponsored activity on or off school property, unless the 2
- 3 student has a permit and is on active duty as a member of a volunteer fire fighting organization or a

- volunteer emergency medical service organization. In order to obtain a permit, the minor must have 4
- 5 secured signed consent from one of his/her parents or legal guardian(s).
- A "personal communication device" is a device that emits an audible signal, vibrates, displays a 6
- 7 message, or otherwise summons or delivers a communication to the possessor.
- A person who discovers a student in possession of a personal communication device shall report the 8
- 9 violation to the principal. The device will be confiscated and forfeited to the district.
- Students who possess a personal communication device are in violation of this policy and school rules 10
- and are subject to the related disciplinary action. 11
