- 1 Students may possess personal communication devices and personal electronic devices. Such devices 2 include, but are not limited to, wearable technology such as eye glasses, rings, or watches that have the capability to record, live stream, or interact with wireless technology; cell phones, laptops, tablets, mp3 3 players, and electronic readers at school. The personal communication devices must be in the off 4 5 mode and must be out of sight unless being used for instructional purposes with the permission of the Students may not use personal communication devices for personal 6 principal or designee. 7 communication during the instructional day but may be allowed to use the personal communication devices before school starts and after school dismisses. The principal or designee may grant a student 8 9 permission to use a personal communication device at the principal's or designee's discretion.
- A person who discovers a student in possession of a personal communication device outside the parameters of this policy shall report the violation to the principal. The device will be confiscated and will be returned only to the parent/guardian of the student through procedures developed by the principal.
- Students who possess a personal communication device in violation of this policy and school rules are subject to disciplinary action.
- A "personal communication device" is a device that emits an audible signal, vibrates, displays a message or picture or otherwise summons or delivers a communication to the possessor.
