Use of Personal Communication Devices and Electronic Devices

- 1 Students may possess personal communication devices and personal electronic devices so long as such
- 2 devices are turned off and stored in backpacks, purses, or personal carry-alls. Such devices include, but
- 3 are not limited to, wearable technology such as eye glasses, rings, or watches that have the capability to
- 4 record, live stream, or interact with wireless technology; cell phones; laptops; tablets; and mp3 players.
- 5 However, a teacher may grant permission for the use of these devices to assist with instruction in his/her
- 6 classroom, and teacher are encouraged to integrate the devices into their course work. The principal or
- 7 his/her designee may also grant a student permission to use such a device at the principal/designee
- 8 discretion.
- 9 Unauthorized use or improper storage of a device will result in confiscation of the device. A student in
- violation of this policy is subject to disciplinary action.
- 11 Use of personal cellular data network plans in not permitted to be used to access the Internet at any time.
- Only HCS Guest wireless should be used to access the Internet during school hours.
- 13 Students are prohibited from using communication or electronic devices in any manner that interferes
- with or is disruptive of the education process, which violates the security or integrity of educational
- material or tests, or which invades the privacy of students, employees, volunteers or visitors.
- 16 Use of cameras on personal communication devices is strictly prohibited on school property or at school
- functions unless authorized by the principal or his/her designee or complete a classroom assignment. A
- student in violation of this policy is subject to disciplinary action.

19 **DISCIPLINE PROCEDURE**

- 20 1st time Phone confiscated for three (3) days.
- 21 2nd time Phone confiscated for five (5) days.
- 22 3rd time Phone confiscated for fifteen (15) days.
- 23 4th time Assigned to Alternative School. Device confiscated for remainder of school year.
- 24 If a student refuses to turn in their cell phone to an administrator when directed, the student will be
- assigned Alternative School for a period of time.
- 26 When the device is confiscated, it must be complete and intact.
- 27 If a cell phone is confiscated in the classroom during a time when a grade is given the student will receive
- a "0" for the grade and the above policy will be enforced.

1 PERSONAL ELECTRONIC DEVICES

- 2 Personal electronic devices such as CD players, gaming devices (PSP, etc.) or MP3 players may be
- 3 stored in backpacks, purses or personal carry-alls. However, the use of device during school hours is
- 4 strictly forbidden unless authorized by the principal or his/her designee. Use or improper storage of the
- 5 personal electronic device will result in confiscation of the device until such time as it may be released
- 6 to the student's parents or guardian. A student in violation of this policy is subject to disciplinary action.
