- 1 A Disciplinary Hearing Authority (DHA) shall conduct appeals for students who have been suspended
- 2 for more than ten (10) school days. ¹ The Board shall appoint members to the DHA which shall consist
- 3 of three (3) members, (maximum number must not exceed total membership of Board) at least one (1)
- 4 of whom shall be a licensed employee of the board, and such appointments are for one (1) year terms
- 5 and subject to reappointment.
- 6 The director of schools shall appoint a chairman of the DHA from the members appointed by the
- 7 Board. The chairman shall perform the following duties:
- 8 1. Set the time, place and date for each hearing;
 - 2. Maintain order and structure during each hearing;
 - 3. Identify the members of the DHA assigned to hear each individual case; and
 - 4. Prepare, sign, and disseminate the minutes of each meeting.
- At the conclusion of each hearing, the chairman shall sign and maintain a copy of the minutes of the

- 14 The DHA shall notify the parent or guardian of the student, the student's parents, and any other
- appropriate person of the time, place, and date of the hearing within forty-eight (48) hours of receiving
- notification of the suspension/expulsion. The notice of the hearing shall include a statement that, unless
- the student's parent or guardian requests an open hearing in writing within five (5) days of receipt of
- notice, any, and all, hearing(s) will be closed to the public.³
- 19 Each hearing shall be conducted by at least three (3) members of the DHA. The hearing must be held,
- a decision must be rendered, and notification of the decision must be provided to the parents and/or
- student and the principal no later than ten (10) days after the beginning of the suspension/expulsion.¹
- 22 The DHA shall provide written notification to the parent or guardian of the student, the student, and
- any other appropriate person of the time, place and date of the hearing. The hearing must be held no
- later than ten (10) days after the beginning of the suspension.¹
- 25 The DHA may take the following disciplinary actions: ²
 - 1. Affirm the decision of the school principal;
 - 2. Order removal of the suspension unconditionally;

- 3. Order removal of the suspension upon such terms and conditions as it deems reasonable;
- 4. Remand the student to alternative placement; or
- 5. Suspend/Expel/Remand the student for a specified period of time.*
- 4 Notification of the decision shall include a statement of the right of either party within five (5) days
- 5 after receiving the decision to request a review by the Director of Schools. If a review of the hearing is
- 6 requested by either the parents or guardian of the involved student or the school principal, the Director
- 7 of Schools shall grant a second hearing.
- 8 The Director of Schools shall either affirm the decision of the hearing authority; or modify the decision
- 9 to either a lesser or greater penalty.*
- 10 Immediately following the hearing, the director of schools shall give his/her decision to the student and
- parent(s) as well as the school principal; this shall include a statement that either party has five days to
- request a review by the Board.
- 13 If the student, principal, principal-teacher or assistant principal requests a review, then the Board shall
- review the record. Following the review, the Board may grant or deny the request for a hearing or
- affirm or overturn the decision of the DHA with or without a hearing. The Board shall not impose a
- more severe penalty than that imposed by the DHA without first providing an opportunity for a hearing
- 17 before the Board.³
- * Note: Zero-tolerance offenses as set forth in statute require mandatory calendar year expulsion or
- assignment to alternative placement for a calendar year unless modified by the Director of Schools.
