1 The Board may deny admission of any student (except those in state custody) who has been expelled
2 or suspended from another school system in Tennessee or another state even though the student
3 has established residency in the system in which s/he seeks enrollment.

4
5 After a request for enrollment is made, the director of schools shall investigate the facts surrounding
6 the suspension/expulsion from the former school system and make a recommendation to the Board
7 to approve or deny the request.

8
9 The Board shall not deny enrollment beyond the length of the imposed suspension/expulsion.

10
11 If the action of the Board is to deny admission, the director of schools shall, on behalf of the Board
12 of Education, notify the Commissioner of Education of the decision.

13
14 Any school system that accepts enrollment of a student from another school system may dismiss the
15 student if it is determined subsequent to the enrollment that the student has been suspended or
16 expelled from the former school system.¹
