1 The superintendent shall develop procedures, programs and plans to promote and protect the health and  
2 wellness of students. These should provide, at a minimum, for the following:

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- 4 1. A student guidance program;
- 5 2. Student health services, including the administration of medications;
- 6 3. Student psychological service;
- 7 4. Student wellness plans; and
- 8 5. Student social services.
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10 The development of these programs and the scope of the services provided shall be contingent on the  
11 availability of resources, both financial and otherwise.

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13 Each school shall provide a guidance program for all students that enlist the cooperative efforts of ad-  
14 ministrators, teachers, school counselors, parents and community resources. The school guidance and  
15 counseling programs shall be established and operated under guidelines adopted by the Tennessee State  
16 Board of Education.

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18 Consultation services with staff, parents, students and resource agencies shall be a primary focus of all  
19 guidance programs; moreover, school administrators and counselors are authorized to work with recog-  
20 nized groups that may furnish special services to students. School counselors shall provide preventive  
21 and developmental counseling to school students in order to prepare them for school responsibilities and  
22 social and physical development.

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24 School counselors shall facilitate the collection and maintenance of student data and record systems, direct  
25 student program planning and placement, provide educational and occupational information for use by  
26 students, parents and teachers and schedule student courses.
