PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS 1

- 2 The principal shall ensure that there is a complete physical examination of each student prior to:
 - 1. Entering school for the first time. This applies to pre-kindergarten, kindergarten, first grade and other students for whom there is no health record;¹ and
 - 2. Participation as a member of any athletic team or in any other strenuous physical activity program.²
- 7 Cost of the examination shall be borne by the parent or guardian of the student. These records shall 8 be on file in the principal's office.³
- Screening tests for vision and hearing will be conducted. Scoliosis and lice screenings may be 9
- 10 conducted. Parents/ Guardians will receive written notice of any screening result that indicates a
- condition that might interfere or tend to interfere with a student's progress. 11
- In general, the school district will not conduct physical examinations of a student without parental 12 consent to do so or by court order, unless the health or safety of the student or others is in question.⁴ 13

14 **IMMUNIZATIONS**

- No students entering school, including those entering pre-kindergarten, kindergarten or first grade, those 15
- from out-of-state, and those from nonpublic schools, will be permitted to enroll (or attend) without 16
- proof of immunization, as determined by the Commissioner of Public Health.^{1,4} It is the 17
- responsibility of the parents or guardians to have their children immunized and to provide such proof 18
- to the principal of the school which the student is to attend.⁴ 19
- 20 Exceptions, in the absence of an epidemic or immediate threat thereof, will be granted to any child
- whose parent or guardian shall file with school authorities an appropriate signed form that states 21
- such measures conflict with his/her religious tenets and practices; or due to medical reasons if such 22
- 23 child has a written statement from his/her doctor excusing him from such immunization.⁵
- Proof of exceptions will be in writing and filed in the same manner as other immunization records. 24
- 25 A list of transfer students shall be kept at each school throughout the school year in order that their
- 26 records can be monitored by the Department of Health and Environment.
