1 No student will be denied an education solely because of a communicable disease, and his/her educational
2 program shall be restricted only to the extent necessary to minimize the risk of transmitting the disease.
3

4 Parents or guardians of infected students shall inform appropriate school officials of the infection so that
5 proper precautions for the protection of other students, employees, and the infected student shall be taken.
6

7 No student with a communicable disease which may endanger the health of either himself/herself or other
8 individuals will enter or remain in the regular school setting.^{1,2} If a school principal has reason to believe
9 a student has a communicable disease which may endanger the health of either himself/herself or other
10 individuals in the regular school setting, the principal shall:

- 11 1. Assign the student to a setting which will protect other students, employees and the student
12 himself; or
- 13 2. Exclude the student from school until certification is obtained from a physician or the County
14 Health Department by either the parent or principal stating that the disease is no longer commu-
15 nicable.

19 If the principal has reason to believe that the student has a long-term communicable disease, the principal
20 must require confirmation from a physician or the County Health Department as to the student's condition.
21 If the student is confirmed to have a long-term communicable disease the principal shall refer the student
22 for special education services.³

24 The principal may request that further examinations be conducted by a physician or County Health
25 Department and may request periodic re-examinations after the student has been readmitted to the school.²

27 The names of all students excluded from school under this policy will be forwarded to the office of the
28 director of schools.
