1 The director of schools shall develop and maintain an Emergency Allergy Response Plan that meets state
 2 guidelines for managing students with life-threatening allergies. The Plan shall include measures to reduce
 3 exposure to allergens and procedures to treat allergic reactions. Components of the plan shall include,
 4 but are not limited to; education and training of personnel, record keeping/documentation, development
 5 and reviews of the allergy action plan, and protocols for classrooms and cafeterias that include strategies
 6 to reduce exposure to allergens.¹

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 8 Using the state food allergy guidelines plan as a guide, the director/designee shall also develop a process
 9 to identify all students with serious allergies (including, but not limited to, food allergies) and develop
 10 and implement an Individualized Health Care Plan (IHCP) with an Allergy Action Plan for each specific
 11 student, as needed.²
