1 The Board directs the administration to identify migratory students in the district, as required by law,  
2 and to develop written administrative procedures for ensuring that migrant students receive services  
3 for which they are eligible. In developing and implementing a program to address the needs of mi-  
4 gratory students the district will:<sup>1</sup>

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- 6 1. Identify migratory students and assess the educational and related health and social needs of  
7 each student.
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- 9 2. Provide a full range of services to migrant students including applicable Title I programs, special  
10 education, gifted education, vocational education, language programs, counseling programs,  
11 elective  
12 classes, fine arts classes, etc.
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- 14 3. Provide migratory children with the opportunity to meet the same statewide assessment standards  
15 that all students are expected to meet.
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- 17 4. To the extent feasible, provide advocacy and outreach programs to migratory students and  
18 their families and professional development for district staff.
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- 20 5. Provide parents an opportunity for meaningful participation in the program.
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22 If a migrant student is identified by the district, the director of schools or designee will notify the  
23 Tennessee State Department of Education and request assistance if needed.
