1 The Board directs the administration to identify migratory students in the Benton County School System  
2 as required by law and to develop written administrative procedures for ensuring that migrant students  
3 receive services for which they are eligible. In developing and implementing a program to address the  
4 needs of migratory students, the Benton County School System will:<sup>1</sup>

- 6 1. Identify migratory students and assess the educational and related health and social needs of  
7 each student.
- 8
- 9 2. Provide a full range of services to migrant students including applicable Title I programs,  
10 special education, gifted education, vocational education, language programs, counseling  
11 programs, elective classes, fine arts classes, etc.
- 12
- 13 3. Provide migratory children with the opportunity to meet the same statewide assessment stan-  
14 dards that all students are expected to meet.
- 15
- 16 4. To the extent feasible, provide advocacy and outreach programs to migratory students and  
17 their families and professional development for district staff.
- 18
- 19 5. Provide parents an opportunity to participate in the program.

21 If a migrant student is identified by the district, the director of schools or designee shall notify the  
22 Tennessee Department of Education and request assistance if needed.
