1 The Board believes students of the system should be allowed to participate in activities which would earn
2 them awards, scholarships and recognition. All activities covered by this policy must be educationally
3 sound and related to curricular and extracurricular activities normally sponsored by the school.

5 Principals of each school will observe the following guidelines before approving any award or scholar-
6 ship:

- 8 1. Students must benefit in some way.
- 9
- 10 2. Programs designed to promote or advertise a product or an ideology will not be approved.
- 11
- 12 3. Programs which require individual efforts by student are preferred.
- 13
- 14 4. Programs must be open to all students.
- 15
- 16 5. Programs must not place an undue burden on the student, teacher or school.
- 17
- 18 6. Entry fees, if any, must be minimal.
- 19
- 20 7. Programs may not interfere with the academic program.
- 21
- 22 8. Travel requirements will be minimal.
- 23
- 24 9. Scholarships are regarded as the most desirable type of award.

- 26 10. Payments of cash awards to individuals will not be encouraged.
