## What Can Be Recycled?

### Plastics

- PETE #1
- HPDE #2

### Metals

- Aluminum Cans
- Steel (Tin) Cans

### Paper Products

- Newsprint
- Office Paper
- Corrugated Cardboard
- Fiber Board
- Magazines
- Catalogs
- Junk Mail
- Telephone Books

**Hopkinsville-Christian County Recycling Program**  
**WHAT ITEMS ARE ALLOWED?**  
**Plastics:** #1 (PETE), #2 (HDPE)  
**Metals:** Aluminum Drink Cans, Steel (Tin) Food Cans  
**Paper Products:** Magazines, Phone Books, Newsprint,  
Office Paper, Corrugated Cardboard, Paper Board (cereal boxes)

**RULES:**  
Place items in container in **LOOSE** form.  
Remove all lids and Rinse.

**NO** plastic bags! Return grocery bags to the store.  
**NO** medical waste such as syringes or pill bottles.  
**NO** motor oil or antifreeze jugs, paint containers.  
**NO** Styrofoam (Egg Cartons, etc)  
**NO** Aerosols (Hair Spray, Deodorant, Paint, etc.)

## Do I Have to Rinse Out My Recyclables?

Please remove all lids & give the item a quick rinse. NO food or liquid should be present in the container at the time of drop-off. Rinsing items will help keep the drop-off facility clean. It will also prevent bugs, odors, and sticky residue that will contaminate materials in our recycling bins
