

TRENTON ISD MEDICATION POLICY

*Trenton ISD **DOES NOT PROVIDE** any medications. **All medications** given to a student for occasional ailments while at school **must be furnished by the parent/guardian**. This includes medications such as, but not limited to:

Tylenol (acetaminophen)

Ibuprofen (Motrin, Advil)

Antibiotic ointment for cuts or scrapes

Hydrocortisone or Benadryl (diphenhydramine) cream for itchy rashes or bites

Calamine for poison ivy

*An Over-the-Counter Medication form **MUST** be filled out for each medication **prior** to being given.

*A Prescription Medication form **MUST** be filled out and signed by the physician and parent or guardian **before** any prescription medications can be given.

* **ALL** medications **must** be in the **original** bottle and **properly** labeled **with** the student's name on it and within the expiration date printed on the bottle.

***No** medication may be kept on a student's person without permission from either the school principal or the school nurse. Please contact the school nurse for **EXCEPTIONS** to this rule.

*Only prescription medications that **must** be given during school will be administered.
