

SCHOOL DISTRICT AND BOARD LEGAL STATUS

The County Board of Education is an agent of the State of West Virginia. It is a quasi-public corporation, existing only under statute, having only the power given by statute and such implied powers as are absolutely necessary to execute such express powers. The administrative unit employed is that of a county unit as created by the West Virginia Legislature in 1933. This board shall be a corporation known as "The Board of Education of the County of Tyler, State of West Virginia." The County Board of Education is responsible to the State and Citizenry of the County for the supervisions and control of public education within the county in accordance with laws and policies established by the State Constitution, State Legislature, State Board of Education and the Board of Education of the County of Tyler.
