

TYLER COUNTY POLICY: BD

SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER ELECTIONS AND TERM OF OFFICE

The Tyler County School District is under the supervision and control of a five member board of education. The members of the Board are elected by the voters of the county without reference to political party affiliation. No more than two members shall be elected from any one magisterial district. Members are elected at the spring primary election for a four-year term of office. New members take office on the first day of July following the primary election at which time they are elected.

The term of office of any member of the board of education shall immediately cease, and a vacancy shall exist, upon occurrence of ineligibility as prescribed in section one-a (18-5-1a) of state code.
