BOARD POLICY DEVELOPMENT AND REVIEW OF EXISTING POLICIES

The Board recognized that the development of sound educational policies is a complex and continuous process. Policy statements may become outdated or contain inconsistencies which will need to be revised and updated periodically.

It shall be the Superintendent's responsibility to coordinate an annual review of all Board policies for current relevance, accuracy and necessity. To insure an orderly policy development, all proposed new policies or revisions to existing policies shall be placed on a minimum two-week comment period prior to any Board action.

As new policies or changes are adopted, copies will be distributed to every school, bus garage, and central office to be placed in the Tyler County Manuals.

By a majority vote of the Board, any policy or regulation may be suspended, amended, or revoked.

In case of emergency, the Superintendent may suspend any part of these policies and regulations as they pertain to the administration of schools. Board members will be notified as soon as possible regarding such action. At the following Board meeting, it shall then be determined by the Board whether the suspension shall expire at the time of said report or continued in effect by the Board.

In situations where action must be taken within the school system where the Board has provided no guidelines, policy, or regulations, the Superintendent shall have the power to take prudent action. The decision shall be subject to review by action of the Board at its next meeting. The Superintendent shall inform the Board of any such actions and of the need for policy to govern such situations.
