Given its size and complexity, a number of other administrative positions have been created to assist in administering Tyler County Schools. Working cooperatively, under the direction of the Superintendent, the administrative staff is responsible for the long range planning, resource determination, program implementation, and total evaluation necessary to provide the best possible education for all Tyler County students.
