

PROPERTY AND EQUIPMENT SALE

If, at any time, the board shall ascertain that any building, land, or other property shall no longer be needed for educational purposes, the board may sell, dismantle, remove, or relocate any such building and sell the land on which they are located, at public auction, after proper notice, and on such terms as it orders, to the highest responsible bidder. The proceeds of such sales shall be placed on the credit of such funds of the district as the board may direct.

In rural communities the grantor of the lands, his heirs, or assigns, shall have the right to purchase the land, exclusive of the buildings, and mineral rights, at the same price for which it was originally sold.

Equipment and equipment parts no longer in use and with no expected future use in any school or department and having a value of more than \$100.00 shall be declared surplus by the Board. Surplus items will be advertised and sold through an appropriate bidding process. Items which cannot be sold shall be donated or discarded.
