

SCHOOL BUS MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION

The Board of Education shall be responsible for the establishment of a school bus maintenance program that will assure, insofar as is possible, the safe operating condition of all buses in the transportation of school pupils.

Every vehicle used to transport pupils will be scheduled by the Transportation Director for maintenance on a time and/or mileage basis that reflects good preventive maintenance. All buses must be inspected one (1) time per year, through the State Department of Education.

All major repair work shall be done at the school bus garage. Maintenance and service records of each vehicle in the school bus fleet shall be maintained. An inventory of school bus chassis and body components that are periodically replaced shall also be maintained.
