

SCHOOL BUS SECURITY/SAFETY SYSTEMS

All regular Tyler County school buses are equipped with a bus intercom system. Drivers are required to use the intercom when any student is crossing a street or highway when boarding or departing the bus.

As an additional security measure, a video/audio recorder shall be placed on all school buses.

School buses shall display lighted head lamps at all times when upon the highway.

A school bus operator shall submit a complaint directly to a magistrate without first presenting the complaint to the prosecuting attorney or other law-enforcement agency, if the complaint is based on a violation of WV Code 17C-12-7 (a) – passing a school bus that is stopped for the purpose of receiving or discharging students.
