

FOOD SERVICES – FREE AND REDUCED

The Tyler County Board of Education hereby assumes responsibility for and will implement uniformly the following policy with respect to determining the eligibility of children for free and reduced price school meals in all National School Lunch Program and Breakfast Program schools. The Tyler County Board of Education is required to serve free and reduced price meals to students determined eligible by the current USDA Income Eligibility Guidelines.

In fulfilling its responsibilities, each school agrees: (1) to serve meals for free or at a reduced price to children who are determined by local school officials to be unable to pay the full price of the meal; (2) to permit no physical segregation of, or any other discrimination against, any child due to inability to pay the full price of the meal; and (3) to serve free meals or at a reduced price to any child who is a member of a family within annual income at or below the applicable family size income level adopted by the West Virginia Department of Education, which, as a minimum, meets the level set forth in the Income Poverty Guidelines currently prescribed by the Secretary of Agriculture.
