

FACILITIES PLANNING

Each county Board of Education has the responsibility to maintain a sufficient number of suitable school facilities to provide a thorough and efficient system of education and equal educational opportunities for its public school students.

To this end, Tyler County Schools shall develop a Comprehensive Educational Facilities Plan as described in the WV Handbook on Planning School Facilities. This Plan shall serve as the centerpiece for Board decisions regarding all facilities and major improvement needs. It shall be a working document for planning construction and renovations, and shall be reviewed annually and amended, as needed.

In accordance with WV Code 18-9D-16, the Board shall also develop and annually update a ten-year Major Improvement Plan for all facilities. This Plan shall identify and prioritize renovations, construction, and major maintenance needs.

Any suggested renovations or additions to school facilities or grounds shall require prior Board approval and a recommendation from the building Principal, regardless of the funding source(s).
